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

<b>Storage and Handling:</b>	Quick spin the vial after receiving. The antibody solution should be stored undiluted between 2°C and 8°C, and protected from prolonged exposure to light. Do not freeze.
<b>Recommended Usage:</b>	For ELISA applications, this antibody can be used at 0.5-1.0 µg/mL as the detection antibody. However, optimization by titration is suggested for best performance in each specific application.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

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This antibody is raised against a synthetic 6xHis peptide. It can be used for Western blotting to detect His-tagged proteins (6xHis or more) at the N-terminus, C-terminus, or within the protein sequence. It is also suitable for flow cytometry or immunofluorescent staining of His-tagged proteins.

## PRODUCT DATA



Recombinant protein with His tag is coated at 50 ng<sub>mL</sub> (5 ng<sub>well</sub>). Biotin anti-His antibody can detect His tagged protein in the dose dependent manner. For ELISA application, this antibody can be used at 0.5-1.0 ug<sub>mL</sub> as the detection antibody.

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
